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RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL & ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION

1. GayDayS® reserves the right to make amendments to these Rules and Regulations at any time. All contestants will be notified where amended Rules and Regulations may be accessed and the date they will take effect within 48 hours of amendment.
2. Any matter not covered by these rules and regulations shall be addressed immediately and any necessary decisions will be decided by the President, Entertainment Team, or other designated representative of GayDayS®, Inc.
3. Complete honesty and full disclosure are expected from all contestants. Any affiliations, issues, or concerns that could reflect poorly on the individual candidates and GayDayS® must be divulged to GayDayS® immediately. GayDayS® reserves the right to investigate any claims regarding any contestant that could be potentially damaging to the reputation of both the contestant and GayDayS®. GayDayS® also reserves the right to make any determinations and decisions on how to proceed pending the results of their investigations.
4. GayDayS® will provide a Pageant Manager as your primary point of contact for the Miss GayDayS® Pageant from time of registration until the crowning of Miss GayDayS® 2020. Any questions, concerns, ideas or requests should be directed to the Pageant Manager, Harmony Breeze, Miss GayDayS® 2014. He/She will report all matters to the GayDayS® Entertainment Team and assist with resolving problems, answering questions, providing direction, and ensuring that contestants have an enjoyable time.
5. Miss GayDayS® candidates must be legally male at least 21 years of age as of October 31st, 2020. All contestants must possess a valid government issued ID, such as a Driver's License or passport, issued in their own name which shall be presented at time of on-site registration to show proof of age.
6. All dancer(s), assistant(s), dresser(s), stylist(s), employee(s), and/or other helper(s) must be at least 18 years of age and possess a valid government issued ID, such as a Driver's License or passport, issued in their own name which shall be presented at time of on-site registration to show proof of age.
7. The Miss GayDayS® Pageant does not discriminate against entertainers with surgical and medical enhancements, such as silicone and hormones. Physical enhancements **will not be considered** by any judge in the scoring of contestants. All Miss GayDayS® contestants must have been born male.
8. Illegal drugs and/or marijuana use, distribution, or possession by any Miss GayDayS® contestant during the pageant will not be tolerated. Any contestants found in violation of this rule **will be**



immediately disqualified. This rule will remain in effect for the full year reign of the Miss GayDayS® Pageant winner. The Miss GayDayS® title will be stripped from the winner and passed to the first runner up if found in violation of this rule. Legal action may be taken at the discretion of GayDayS®, Inc.

9. Illegal drugs and/or marijuana use, distribution, or possession by any dancer(s), assistant(s), dresser(s), stylist(s), employee(s), or other helper(s) of a Miss GayDayS® contestant during the pageant will not be tolerated. The contestant whose dancer(s), assistant(s), dresser(s), stylist(s), employee(s), or other helper(s) is found in violation of this rule **will be immediately disqualified.** Legal action may be taken at the discretion of GayDayS®, Inc.
10. Any contestant who is caught in the act of stealing or tampering with another person's costumes, props, or other possessions **will be immediately disqualified,** removed from the location of the pageant and denied access to the event.
11. Any contestant whose dancer(s), assistant(s), dresser(s), stylist(s), employee(s), significant others or other helper(s) is caught in the act of stealing or tampering with another person's costumes, props, or other possessions **will be immediately disqualified,** and the individual caught stealing or tampering will be removed from the location of the pageant and denied access to the event.
12. Any contestant who is found to be intoxicated at any GayDayS® Inc. event **will be immediately disqualified,** removed from the location and denied access to the event.
13. Any dancer(s), assistant(s), dresser(s), stylist(s), employee(s), or other helper(s) of a Miss GayDayS® contestant who is found to be intoxicated at any Miss GayDayS® Pageant event will be immediately removed from the location of the pageant and denied access to the event. The contestant whose dancer(s), assistant(s), dresser(s), stylist(s), employee(s), or other helper(s) who is found to be intoxicated at any Miss GayDayS® Pageant event may be subject to scoring penalization at the discretion of the President or Entertainment Team of GayDayS®, Inc., or the Miss GayDayS® Pageant Coordinator.
14. Any contestant causing damage to any GayDayS® venue, inclusive of decorations and equipment, or any portion of the GayDayS® host hotel **will be immediately disqualified** and may be subject to legal action. If legal action is pursued, GayDayS® will assist the venue and any owner of damaged property with any prosecution.
15. Any contestant whose dancer(s), assistant(s), dresser(s), stylist(s), employee(s), or other helper(s) is caught causing damage to any Gay Days® venue, inclusive of decorations and equipment, or any portion of the GayDayS® host hotel **will be immediately disqualified** and may



be subject to legal action. If legal action is pursued, GayDayS® will assist the venue and any owner of damaged property with any prosecution.

16. It is recommended that contestants arrive at all scheduled appointments and events at least fifteen (15) minutes early. Any contestant that arrives late to any scheduled appointment or event may be subject to scoring penalization at the discretion of the President or Entertainment Team of GayDayS®, Inc., or the Miss GayDayS® Pageant Manager.
17. Hotel towels shall not be used for the removal of make-up. Contestants must provide their own towels for this purpose. Any contestant found in violation of this rule will be fined \$10.00 per towel and may be subject to scoring penalization at the discretion of the President or Entertainment Team of GayDayS®, Inc., or the Miss GayDayS® Pageant Coordinator.
18. The Miss GayDayS® Pageant will be themed. All contestants will be required to adhere to the chosen theme. The theme and all pertinent information and requirements will be communicated to all contestants who will be competing in the Miss GayDayS® Pageant at GayDayS® Orlando upon their selection in accordance with the preliminary judging process.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Candidates must submit all the following for the application to be considered complete:
 - a. A completed Miss GayDays® Pageant Official Application which will include:
 - i. Personal information (Stage and legal name, age, date of birth, and contact information)
 - ii. Brief personal biography
 - iii. Community involvement, accolades, and awards
 - iv. Any Social Media links (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.)
 - v. Responses to two questions
 - vi. Type of talent that will be performed
 - vii. List of additional personnel and their role or relationships (dancers, assistants, dressers, stylists, employees, significant others or other helpers)
 - viii. List of sponsors
 - b. One (1) 5"x7" headshot photo in full performance attire
 - i. If digitally submitted must be a minimum resolution of 300dpi
 - c. One (1) 5"x7" photo of contestants as themselves.
 - d. Non-refundable entrance fee of \$200.00 submitted online at www.GayDayS.com. Cash and checks will not be accepted for the entrance fee.
2. Applications must be submitted by email to Pageant@GayDayS.com in one single email.
 - a. Subject of email must include contestant stage name and Miss GayDayS® 2020 Pageant Application
 - b. Body of email must include date payment was made and the following attachments:



- i. Application as one (1) multi-page PDF document
 - ii. Required photos as individual files
 - iii. Proof of on-line payment as one (1) single page PDF document
3. Applications and entrance fees are due by 10:00 pm EST on Wednesday, September 30th, 2020. Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted.
4. By signing and submitting an application, candidates attest that they have read, understand, and agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Miss GayDayS[®] 2020 Pageant.

ACCOMMODATIONS

1. The Margaritaville Resort Orlando is the official host hotel for the 30th Anniversary celebration of GayDayS[®] Orlando 2020 and the Miss GayDayS[®] 2020 Pageant. The hotel is located at: 8000 Fins Up Cir, Kissimmee, Florida 34747
2. Reservations may be made online at www.GayDayS.com or by calling 888-942-9329.
3. It is *not required, but highly recommended* that all Miss GayDayS[®] 2020 Pageant contestants secure accommodations at The Margaritaville Resort Orlando for the duration of the pageant. Contestants are responsible for the payment for their lodging accommodations.
 - a. Those not staying at the host hotel are required to be present for check-in, pageant meetings, and all pageant events and competitions.
 - b. Contestants not staying at the host hotel will also receive one parking pass for parking at the host hotel (based on availability of parking spaces).
4. GayDayS[®] will not provide travel accommodations for the Miss GayDayS[®] Pageant. Contestants are responsible for scheduling and payment for their own airfare or other transportation to the Miss GayDayS[®] Pageant. They are also responsible for any and all transportation expenses before, during, and after the Miss GayDayS[®] Pageant.

PAGEANT INFORMATION

1. Registration will take place Thursday, October 29th, 2020 from 1:00 pm – 1:30 pm at The Margaritaville Resort Orlando. All contestant information will be verified, copies of all participant Identifications will be made, and information regarding location and time of the Mandatory Pageant Participant Meeting will be provided. Failure to register during registration period will result in disqualification.
2. Contestants will receive an evening gown description form at time of registration. Forms should be completely and legibly filled out with only the requested information. The form must be submitted at the Mandatory Pageant Participant Meeting.



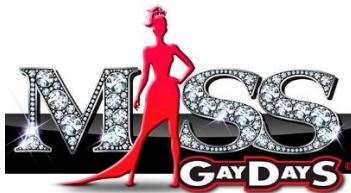
3. Music must be submitted PRIOR TO REGISTRATION via Pageant@GayDayS.com. Please bring a backup on USB clearly marked with contestant's name. Cassette tapes or CD's will not be accepted. Contestants who do not submit their music via EMAIL BY FRIDAY, OCTOBER 23RD, 2020 may be subject to scoring penalization. Backup USB Thumb Drives will be returned to contestants after the crowning of Miss GayDayS® 2020.
 - Track 1 – Themed Presentation Music
 - Track 2 – Talent Music
4. Performance Run Sheets must be submitted at time of registration. Contestants who do not submit their Run Sheet at time of registration may be subject to scoring penalization. The Run Sheet will provide lighting requests, and any other special requests for the contestant's performance to the Pageant Manager and technical team. All special requests will be discussed at the individual contestant's rehearsal. A determination will be made at that time by the Pageant Manager and GayDayS® Entertainment Team whether requests are able to and/or will be fulfilled. Contestant will be informed at rehearsals what decision(s) are made regarding special requests after rehearsals.
5. Each contestant will be allotted twenty (20) minutes for individual rehearsal on Friday, October 30th. Rehearsals should be utilized for sound checks, blocking and lighting cue suggestions, familiarization with the performance space, and ensuring time restrictions can be met. Contestants should be well-organized to best utilize the limited time provided and allow for the timing of required performances.
6. Logistics for performance load-in and load-out will be included in the Mandatory Pageant Participant Rehearsal.
7. Glitter, confetti, fire, liquids, and live animals are **strictly prohibited**. Any contestant attempting to utilize any of the aforementioned will be immediately disqualified, removed from the pageant area, and required to pay for cleaning required and/or repair of any damage caused.
8. This year's theme is "AN INTIMATE NIGHT IN OZ!" Each of the ten (10) final contestants will present themselves in a fantastic OZ inspired performance, whether it be solo, or a small production influenced by ANY of the "Wizard of Oz" productions.

MEETINGS AND EVENT ADMISSION

1. The Mandatory Pageant Participant Meeting will be held on Thursday, October 29th, 2020 at 1:45 pm. All Contestants, dancers, assistants, dressers, stylists, employees and other helpers are required to attend; this meeting will be run by the Miss GayDayS® Pageant Manager. At this meeting, the judges will be introduced (pending availability), rules and regulations will be reviewed (inclusive of scoring and possible score penalties), pageant tickets may be purchased, and the following items will be distributed: contestant badges, backstage and assistant passes, any updated pageant information, and contestant specific schedules with times and locations.



2. All contestants are required to attend the Annual Taste of GayDayS® Orlando Party in full performance attire. The party will be Thursday, October 29th at The Margaritaville Resort Orlando.
3. All dancers, assistants, dressers, stylists, employees, significant others and other helpers not staying at The Margaritaville Resort Orlando must pay for full-price admission to all events except where discounts may be offered. All persons entering any official GayDayS® events must have a valid government issued ID issued to that person.
4. Each contestant will be provided access to the Miss GayDayS® Pageant for themselves and one additional individual. Tickets will be distributed at the end of the Mandatory Pageant Participant Meeting.
5. Each contestant will be provided one backstage pass for each performer, up to FOUR (4), that will appear on stage with the contestant during the pageant. They will also receive one (1) assistant pass that will allow backstage access to one (1) individual for the purpose of assisting the contestant with dressing; makeup, hair, props or other needed assistance. If a contestant has more than one (1) person providing assistance, multiple persons may utilize the assistant pass but only one (1) individual will be granted backstage access at any given time. No extra assistants will be allowed in the dressing area. Any exceptions to this rule must be requested in writing prior to the opening of on-site registration. All requests will be reviewed by the Entertainment Team and Pageant Coordinator and granted or denied at their sole discretion. There will be NO access to electricity in the dressing area. Please plan accordingly!
6. All dancers, assistants, dressers, stylists, employees, significant others and other helpers must purchase pageant tickets. These passes will be available for purchase during the Mandatory Pageant Participant Meeting at the discounted rate of \$15.00 per person for all dancer(s), assistant(s), dresser(s), stylist(s), employee(s), significant others, and other helper(s) listed on the initial contestant application only. Contestants will not be allowed to increase the requested number of passes. Cash or credit card will be accepted for these passes.
7. Miss GayDayS® Pageant general admission tickets are available for \$20.00 per person in advance, \$30.00 per person at the door. Tickets are available for advanced purchase at www.GayDayS.com, or may be purchased at the door. This year's space is much smaller than previous years, with a room capacity of approximately 150 people. We do expect this event to SELL OUT! Please plan in advance, and accordingly!
8. Any misplaced, lost or stolen passes may be replaced at the full event price.



PAGEANT COMPETITION

1. The Miss GayDayS® Pageant will be held at The Margaritaville Resort Orlando. The personal interviews will take place on Friday, October 30th, and are not open to the public. However, interview video footage will be posted on the Official GayDayS® social media sites after all interviews have been completed. Remaining categories will take place on Saturday, October 31st, beginning promptly at 6:30 pm, and the audience will be open to people of all ages. Call-Time for Saturday's pageant event is 4:30 pm. All contestants, performers, and other helpers must check-in with the Pageant Manager by 4:30 pm or may be subject to penalization.
2. Contestants will not be required to wear an event wristband during the Pageant Competition. All other participants will be required to wear an event wristband during the entirety of the Pageant Competition. Judges will be aware of this requirement and it will not affect scoring.
3. The stage dimensions will be 21 feet wide by 12 feet deep with a 6 feet wide by 9 feet long runway. There may or may not be additional set pieces that may require restrictions on the dimensions of costuming and/or props. Contestants will be provided with any restrictions and/or changes within 48 hours of determination and setting of those restrictions and/or changes.
4. A single dressing area will be provided for all contestants, a maximum of four (4) performers per contestant, and one (1) assistant per contestant. The dressing area will be sectioned off and each contestant will be provided with their own dressing space. If a contestant has multiple helpers or assistant, only one (1) will be allowed backstage at a time.
5. Contestants are responsible for storing, loading, and removing their props. The performance room and the dressing space will be open prior to call time to allow contestants to prepare for their performances. Props, costumes and any other items needed for the pageant at this time but note GayDayS® and any of its representatives will not be responsible for any lost or damaged property left unattended. Following the competition, all props and personal belongings must be removed from the venue.

JUDGED CATEGORIES

1. **Personal Interview** – Up to 15 minutes in length. The showcase of “who you are as a person.” Contestants should interview in their everyday gender preference. Interviews will be video recorded and posted on official GayDayS® social media sites.
2. **Themed Presentation** – 2-minute time limit NOT including introduction. The opportunity to introduce yourself, and your theme of “AN INTIMATE NIGHT IN OZ.”
3. **Talent with Swimwear** – 5-minute time limit with 2 minutes of setup and tear down times. An on-stage performance of your choice, featuring a “Swimwear” look.
4. **Evening Gown** – 2+ minute time limit. The opportunity to present your elegance and poise in evening gown fashion *incorporating red*, the official color of GayDayS®, Inc.
5. **Final On-Stage Question** – The opportunity to showcase your public speaking skills.



1. Personal Interview:
 - a. Each contestant will undergo an individual interview by the Miss GayDays® Pageant judging committee. This will afford our judges insight into the character, charisma, personality, and professional and personal lives of each contestant. It will also provide them the opportunity to evaluate basic skills and qualities such as intellect, communication capabilities, attitude, and composure.
 - b. Contestants shall attend interviews as themselves and not their stage persona.
 - c. Contestants should remember that this is a professional, yet casual, interview. Attire should reflect personality while remaining relaxed, and professional. Contestants should select their clothing to allow them to be comfortable and at ease.
 - d. The interview schedule and room location will be provided at the Mandatory Pageant Participant Meeting.
 - i. Personal Interviews will be scheduled for a maximum of 15 minutes.
 - ii. Each interview will be audio/video recorded. Upon conclusion of all interviews, the interview video footage will be posted on the Official GayDayS® social media sites.
2. Presentation Introduction: AN INTIMATE NIGHT IN OZ
 - a. Presentation shall be limited to two (2) minutes.
 - b. Timing of a complete run through of Themed Presentation must be done during the rehearsal period. Themed Presentations will be penalized for exceeding time limit or for failure to provide for timing of presentation.
 - c. Contestants may utilize up to two (2) additional individuals in their presentation. With the contestant, a maximum of three (3) persons may be on stage at any given time.
 - d. Set-up time is not provided so no set props may be used.
 - e. No items may be left on the stage upon exit. This includes clothing, accessories, and any items that may be dropped, thrown, or left on stage.
 - f. Each contestant will conclude their presentation with a live greeting (NOT included in 2 minutes) on the microphone.
3. Talent with Swimwear: Contestant Choice
 - a. The complete Talent with Swimwear presentations shall be limited to a total of nine (9) minutes broken down as follows:
 - i. Performance – five (5) minutes
 - ii. Prop setup – two (2) minutes
 - iii. Prop removal – two (2) minutes
 - b. Timing of a complete run through of the Talent & Swimwear presentation must be done during the rehearsal period. Performances will be penalized for exceeding time limit or for failure to provide for timing of the category.
 - c. Talent is expected to be an upbeat, high energy number. Ballads are strongly discouraged and may not score as high.
 - d. Swimwear look must be incorporated into the Talent with Swimwear category. This look may be a body leotard, body suit, or any costume that is cut with a high leg. Contestants are encouraged to be aware of their body, and unpressured to present an unflattering costume. Contestants may incorporate their swimwear at the beginning, middle, or end, but not for the entirety of their presentation. Swimwear suggestions: Full body swimsuits or French cut.



- e. Any talent performance is acceptable except where injury may be caused to the audience, performers, technicians, or any other individual or group.
 - f. Contestants may utilize up to four (4) additional individuals in their talent presentation. With the contestant, a maximum of five (5) persons may be on stage at any given time.
 - g. Set-up time is provided so props may be used. All props must be free standing and must be secure upon set-up.
 - h. No items may be left on the stage at the end of the time allotted for prop removal. This includes clothing, accessories, set props and any items that may be dropped, thrown, or left on stage.
 - i. Backstage staff will not be provided by GayDayS® to assist with the set-up or tear down of props.
4. Evening Gown Presentation:
- a. Contestants will have a maximum of two (2) minutes to walk the stage and model their evening gown.
 - b. Evening gowns may be any color or style, but must be full length and **incorporate red**, the official color of GayDayS®, Inc. All physical elements (gown, hair, make-up, shoes and accessories) must complement each other and produce the best possible presence and appearance for the contestant.
 - c. Gowns and accessories may be very simple with minimal or no embellishments, may incorporate significant amounts of embellishments, such as rhinestones and beading, or may fall somewhere in between. Regardless of level of embellishment, gowns must fit well and be easily modeled with poise and elegance. Unique combinations, high quality detailing, clean construction and a high fashion air are critical in developing the look expected for a representative of GayDayS®. Keep in mind this is not a “creative eveningwear” competition and costumes should be avoided.
 - d. All judges are requested to be educated about current fashion. Contestants presenting gowns that are outdated may not score as well as those modeling current fashions.
 - e. Contestants will be provided with an evening gown description card at registration that must be turned in at the Mandatory Pageant Participant Meeting. These cards will be read as contestant models their evening wear. Contestants should strive to complete their modeling in the time the card is read but must complete their round within two (2) minutes.
5. Judges’ Final Question
- a. All contestants are asked a final question from the Miss GayDayS® Pageant judges’ panel. Each contestant will randomly draw a judge’s name and is asked a final question by the judge.
 - b. Judges are required to submit a series of questions for approval to the GayDayS® Inc. prior to the pageant.
 - c. Questions will be related to current media hot topics and LGBT related news but are not limited to subjects relating to representing GayDayS®, Inc.



SCORING

1. Scoring for the Miss GayDayS® Pageant will cumulative. Judges will assign each contestant a score for each category based on their personal performance. Performances will be scored individually without comparison to other performances. With this scoring, more than one contestant may receive the same score.
2. Judging score allocation will be as follows:
 - a. Personal Interview Maximum of 20 points per judge
 - b. Judge's Final Question Maximum of 18 points per judge
 - c. Talent with Swimwear Maximum of 16 points per judge
 - d. Themed Presentation Maximum of 15 points per judge
 - e. Evening Gown featuring RED Maximum of 14 points per judge
3. Administrative score allocation will be as follows:
 - a. Administrative Points Maximum of 50 points
 - i. All contestants will begin the competition with 25 Administrative points. Points may be gained for a maximum of 50 points or removed to a minimum of 0 points at the discretion of the Creative Director of Entertainment and Pageant Coordinator.
 - ii. Administrative points may be gained by attending and interacting at official GayDayS® events throughout the week, to be given by GayDayS® Directors or the owners of GayDayS®, INC Chris and Tommy Manley.
 - iii. Documentation of all penalties or gained administrative points will be maintained by the Pageant Coordinator. All penalties will be consistent throughout the competition.

AWARDS & EXPECTATIONS
